### **FILLING IN THE FORM**

**A number of courses have a fee associated with the course. Please refer to the handbook for more details. There is an obligation to pay program elective fees by the due date for the student to continue in the course.**

### **COMPULSORY SUBJECTS – NO CHOICES TO BE MADE**

#### **English / Science / Geography / History**

You do not make any choices in these areas as you will automatically take English and Science in Semester 1 and Semester 2. You will have a semester of Geography and a semester of History.

#### **VCE / VET Courses**

Every student will take one VCE or VET course. You will be in the same course for Semester 1 and Semester 2. On the Course Selection Form you will be asked to provide four choices in order of preference.

#### **Mathematics**

You have a choice of Mathematics courses. Your choices are General Mathematics or Mathematical Methods.

## **Humanities**

All students will have a semester of Geography and a semester of History. Some students will have to take the Economy and Society course, and other students will not, depending on the choice of VCE / VET courses.

Until your VCE / VET course is worked out, you will not know if you are taking the Economy and Society course.

In case you are in a VCE / VET subject in which you are not required to take the Economy and Society course, you will need to indicate on your Course Selection, if you would like to take it as one of your elective courses.

## **Arts**

You will be expected to take one or two Arts courses for the year, depending on what VCE subject you are in. You will need to nominate three choices in the order of preference.

## **Technology**

You will be expected to take one or two Technology courses for the year, depending on what VCE subject you are in. You will need to nominate three choices in order of preference.

## **LOTE**

French or Indonesian is offered for those students who wish to continue to study a language at Year 10. Please indicate in your elective preferences.

## **Elective Courses**

In addition to taking the required courses that make up a balanced course, you will have one elective course each semester. You can use your elective selections to take courses from English, Mathematics, LOTE, Humanities, PASE, Arts or Technology courses. You will need to nominate six choices in order of preference.

**Please do not nominate subjects you have already nominated.**

**If you have chosen VCE Design and Technology - Wood (10VTW) or VCE Materials and Technology – Food Technology (10VTF), you will not be able to do these as an elective subject.**

**Please note:** that in Year 10 Physical Education courses are not compulsory, unlike Year 9 where PE/Sport is compulsory.

If you want to be in these courses you must indicate this in the Course Selection Form. If you do not want to take PASE courses then you need to show what other electives you do want. **YOU MAY NOT** list again any Arts or Technology courses that you have listed earlier. You may indicate courses you have not previously listed.

In order to complete your subject choices for 2010, you must access your School email account.


