COMPULSORY SUBJECTS – NO CHOICES TO BE MADE

English / Science / SOSE / Mathematical Methods / Physical Education - Core

In addition to the core program that is provided for Accelerated Learning Program students, they have access to courses from The Arts, Technology, LOTE, PASE, Humanities and English learning areas.

VCE / VET COURSES

You will take a VCE or a VET course as part of your program next year. You are in the same course for the year. For example, if you are in VCE Biology in Semester 1, you are expected to be in VCE Biology in Semester 2.

Choose carefully as your VCE course will be determined on what you indicate on this form. This is **NOT** a survey. In other words, by filling in the Course Selection Form, you are choosing your VCE /VET course. **Please note: due to timetabling constraints all courses cannot be offered.**

You will need to nominate three choices in the order of preference.

TECHNOLOGY

You are expected to take one Technology course for the year. Nominate three in order of preference.

ARTS

You are expected to take one Arts course for the year. Nominate three in order of preference.

Elective Courses

In addition to taking the required courses that make up a balanced course, you will have one elective course each semester. You can use your elective selections to take courses from English, Mathematics, LOTE, Humanities, PASE, Arts or Technology. You will need to nominate six choices in order of preference.

Please do not nominate subjects you have already nominated. If you have chosen VCE Design and Technology - Wood (10VTW) or VCE Materials and Technology – Food Technology (10VTF), you will not be able to do these as an elective subject.

YOU MAY NOT list again any Arts or Technology courses that you have listed earlier. You may indicate courses you have not previously listed.

In order to complete your subject choices for 2010, you must access your School email account.


You should see the following page in your web browser.

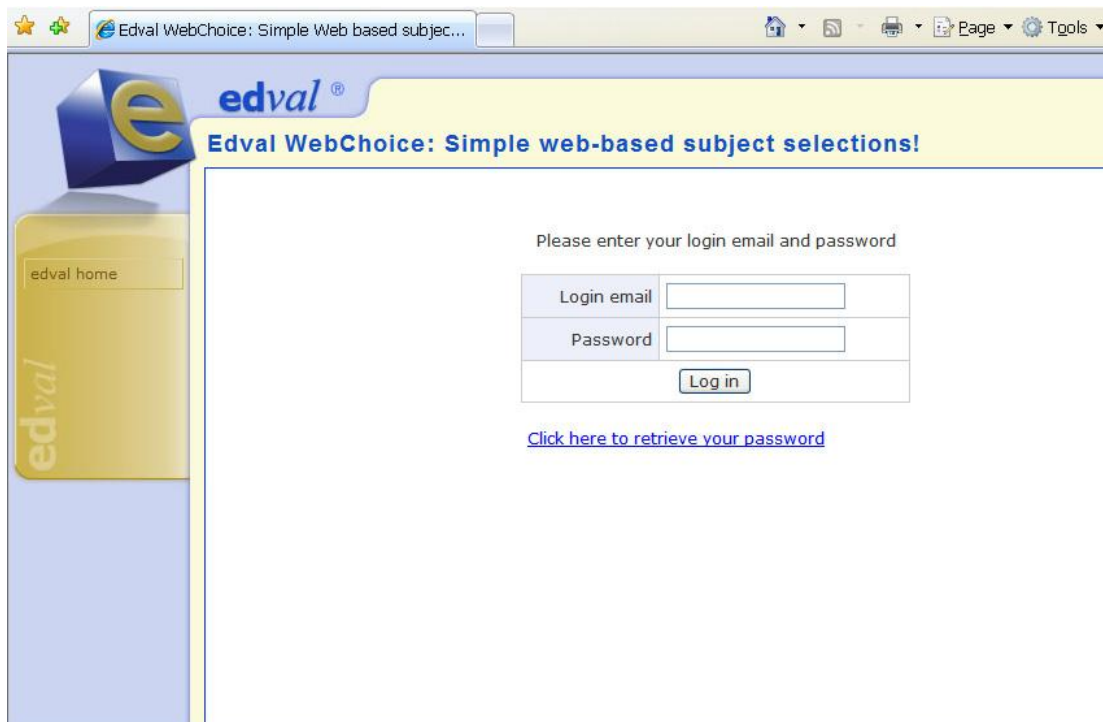
