COMPULSORY COURSES FOR ALL YEAR 9 STUDENTS

English / Mathematics / Science / Humanities (Economics/Geography/History) / Sport / Exploring Art

Do not make any choices in these courses as these courses are compulsory and you will automatically take them in your form group.

ELECTIVES

Technology

You are required to take three Technology units during the year. You will need to nominate five choices in order of preference.

Arts

In addition to the compulsory Art unit which you take with your form group, you are required to take one additional Arts unit during the year. You will need to nominate four choices in order of preference.

PASE

In addition to taking the compulsory Physical Education course for the year, you are required to take two elective Physical Education courses for the year. You will need to nominate four choices in order of preference.

Note: If interested in the Duke of Edinburgh Program please include the application form, which can be located on the School's website, with your nominations.

EXTRA ELECTIVE COURSES

In addition to taking the required courses that make up a balanced course, you will have one elective course each semester (two for the year). You can use your elective choices to take elective subjects from English, Mathematics, LOTE, Humanities, PASE, Arts or Technology. You will need to **nominate six choices** in order of preference.



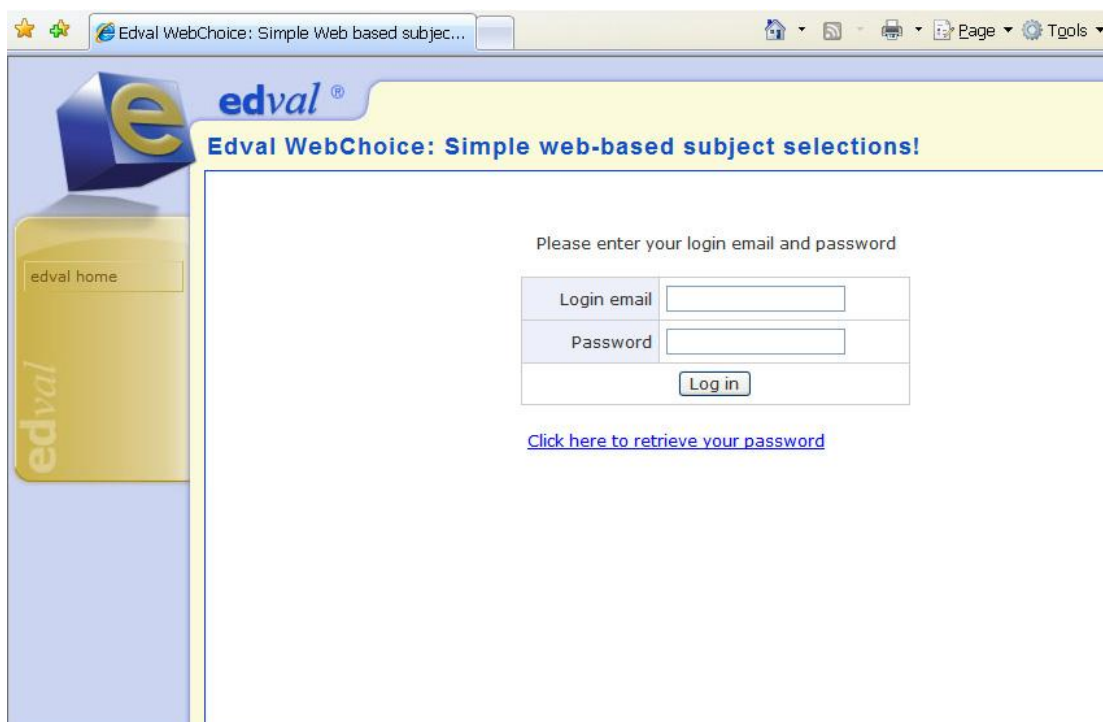
